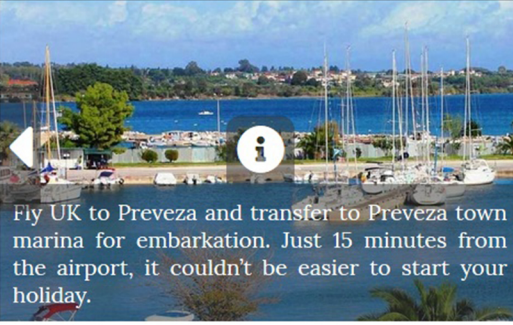


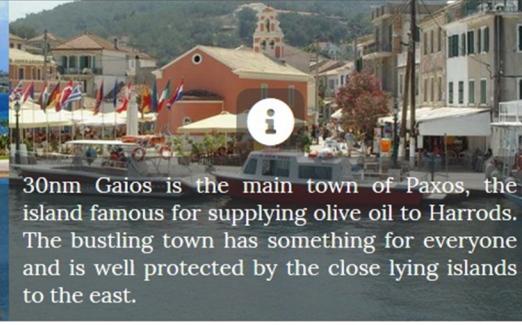
# Corfu Route

## Gaios, Paxos Monday



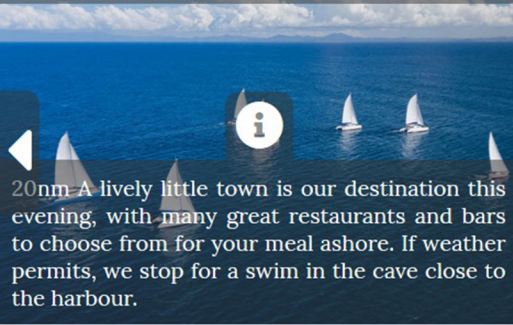

## Corfu Town Tuesday



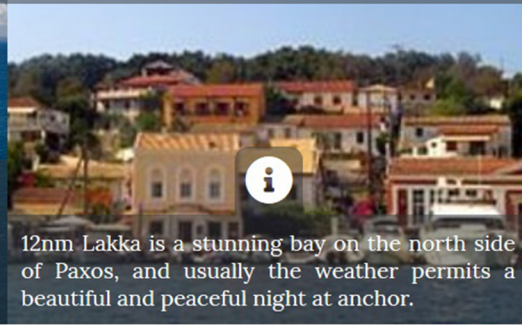

## Lakka Paxos Thursday



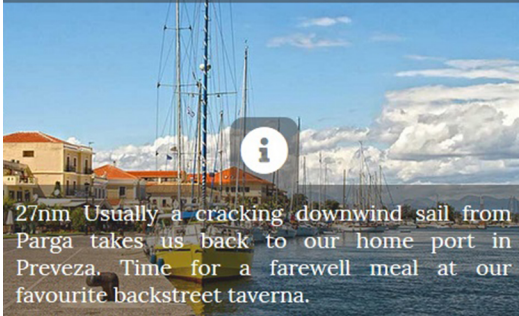
12nm Lakka is a stunning bay on the north side of Paxos, and usually the weather permits a beautiful and peaceful night at anchor.

## Parga, Mainland Friday



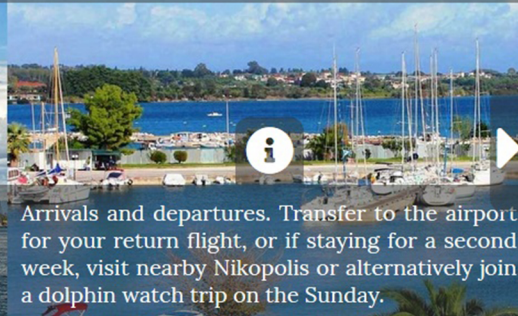
